3. Bright gleams the morn - ing, sail - or, up - lift the eye;



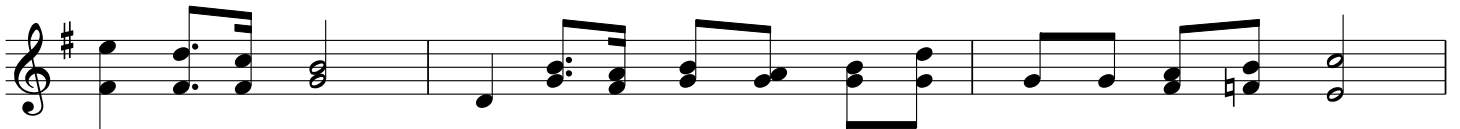
See o'er the foam-ing bil-lows fair ha-ven's land, Drear was the voy-age, sail - or,
